Jerry D. Holst, age 67, of Little Falls, passed away peacefully at his home on Wednesday, May 6, 2026, surrounded by his children. His favorite golfing partner, and fellow "Dodge Boy," was his father, Lloyd, with whom he shared countless memorable rounds with. Jerry also found great beauty in nature. 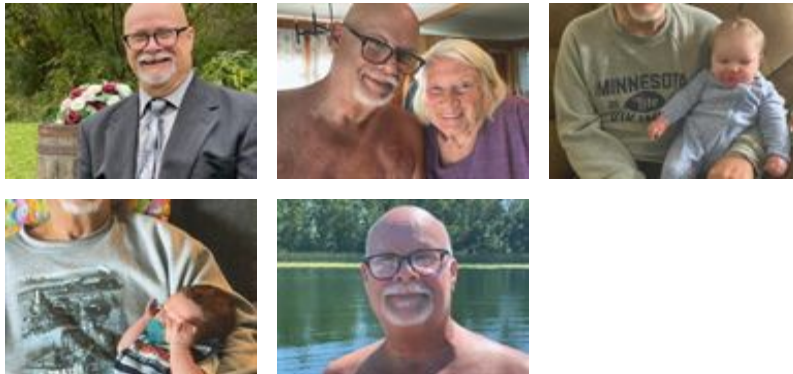
