Jody Boedigheimer, 65 year old resident of Lincoln, MN passed away peacefully Friday, February 9, 2024 at her home. She continued to

sub until the time of her death. Jody was an avid reader and passed on many books to family and friends. She loved the lake, especially swimming and was always the last one out of the water. Jody also liked to travel and see new places and enjoyed planting her flower gardens and seeing them bloom. She loved to bird watch and fed them faithfully along with her much loved pets. Jody was a member of the Lincoln Lakes Ladies Aide and was the current treasurer and was an active member of St. Michael's Catholic Church in Motley, MN and funeral committee. She also belonged to the local ADK . Jody was a loving and caring sister and always put Jane's interests first. She was an amazing and generous friend to many. 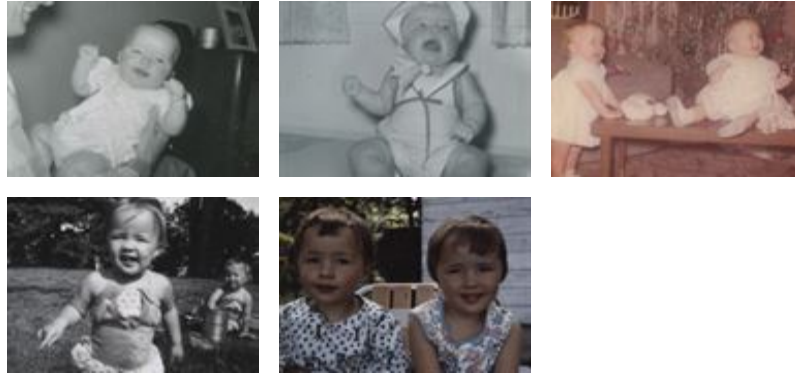
