John "Jack" Hasser, 90-year-old resident of Wahkon, MN passed away on Wednesday, November 20, 2019 at the St. Cloud Hospital in St. Cloud, MN. A Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 10:30 AM on Saturday, November 23, 2019 at Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Wahkon, MN with Father Jerry Schik, OSC officiating. Jack was involved in the Isle Lions, VFW Post 2816, and the Knights of Columbus. He loved God faithfully and his family unconditionally. No matter who you were he made you feel special.

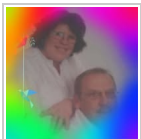
