John Herbert Thompson was born August 12, 1953 to Herbert and Gladys (Cluever) Thompson at St. Gabriel's Hospital in Little Falls, Minnesota. He was baptized and confirmed in St. Peter's Lutheran Church. He grew up in Swanville and attended Swanville Public School. After graduating in 1971, he attended Brainerd Community College and St. Cloud State University. After school he was employed by the First State Bank of Swanville and later by Perfection Crane & Hoist in Swanville for nine years until his death. On October 29, 1977 he married Roxanne Carol Loven of rural Swanville and to this marriage two daughters, Joy Ellen and Crystal Lea, were born. On August 24, 2007 he married Sandra Jean Schweigert who now survives him. John was well-known and loved in Swanville. He was active in the community serving on the Swanville Rural Fire Department and being a member of the Swanville Lions Club, St. Peter's Lutheran Church and the Pheasants Forever Organization. He loved the outdoors and enjoyed hunting, fishing, camping and snowmobiling. His family was very important to him and they are proud of him for many things, especially as he approached his tenth year of sobriety. In 2008, John and Sandra built a new home in rural Swanville which was his dream. On January 22, 2009 he was suddenly taken from this life as he rested in his home. John is survived by his wife Sandra; daughters Joy Thompson of Minneapolis and Crystal and John Goodale of Maple Grove; stepdaughter Amber Terhaar of Braham; parents Herbert and Gladys Thompson of Swanville; brothers Mark and Tammie Thompson of Decorah, Iowa and Paul
