Then he was drafted into the Army and served during the Korean Conflict. After the Army he worked at Palm Tool in Coon Rapids, then Clow Stamping in Merrifield and retired from Acro Metal in Brainerd. He also owned "JRS" garage. After retirement Joe worked at Father Hennepin State Park in Isle, MN. Joe and Bonnie enjoyed going to Joe's Army reunions every 2 years. Joe really enjoyed seeing all his "old" Army buddies. Joe loved cutting wood, snowmobiling, making toys and walking sticks out of wood, but most of all he loved his Ford tractors. Joe enjoyed deer hunting and just being in the woods. He and his wife Bonnie drove to Alaska and also camped at most of the State Parks in Minnesota, they loved hiking. Three years ago he went to live in Pierz at the Pierz Villa due to his Parkinsons disease.
