



## June G. McCoy

June G. McCoy, 79 year old resident of Little Falls, MN passed away Thursday, January 18, 2018 at Highland Senior Living in Little Falls. A Funeral service will be held at 12:30 p.m. on Tuesday, January 23, 2018 at the Shelley Funeral Chapel in Little Falls, with Rev. Clayton Wilfer officiating. Burial will be held at 2:00 p.m. on Tuesday at the Minnesota State Veterans Cemetery north of Little Falls. A visitation will be held from 12 noon to 12:30 p.m. Tuesday at the funeral home.

June Margaret Gerlach was born in Morris, Minnesota to Harold and Rose (Stein) Gerlach. The family moved to Upsala, Minnesota, where she attended the Upsala schools. After graduating, she attended Gail Institute in Minneapolis. June then moved to Washington, D.C., where she worked for the United States Marine Corps Reserve. She then moved back to Minneapolis and worked for the 14th Army Corps Reserve, and it was there that she met her husband, Harold (Mac) McCoy, who was a career Army serviceman. June and Mac married and two days later, Mac was sent to Thailand. June followed a month later and they stayed in Thailand for two years while Mac was the Command Sergeant Major of the joint service detachment in Bangkok. After conclusion of their tour in Thailand, Mac and June were transferred to Fort Monroe, Virginia for duty. Mac served an additional 2 tours in Vietnam after this and retired in 1970. They then moved to St. Augusta, MN. After their son Tim joined the service, Mac and June moved to Little Falls, MN.

June is survived by her son, Timothy (Cindy) McCoy of Yuma, AZ; grandchildren, Jackilyn (Ruben) Valesano and Greg (Aline) McCoy; great grandchildren, Riley, Oliver, Summer, and Aria; 3 sisters and 1 brother.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Harold and Rose; and husband, Harold.

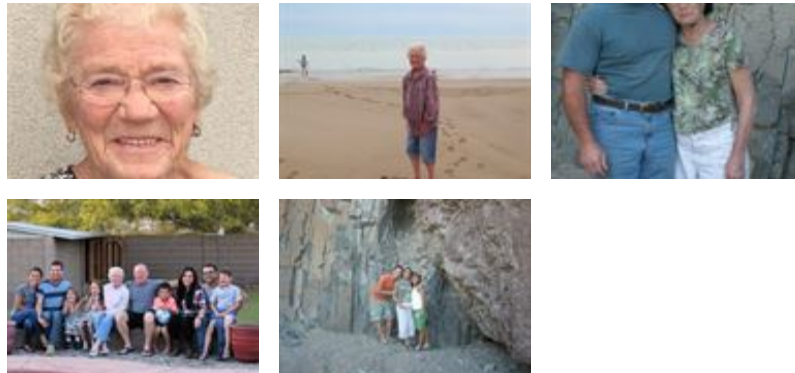

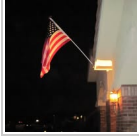
