



## Kenneth Lowe

November 19, 1935 - June 14, 2024

Kenneth Lowe, 88 year old resident of Little Falls, MN, passed away Friday, June 14, 2024, at Highland Senior Living in Little Falls. A graveside service will be held on Thursday, July 11, 2024, at 11:00 A.M., at the Minnesota State Veterans Cemetery with Rev. Tony Romaine officiating. Burial will take place at the Minnesota State Veterans Cemetery north of Little Falls. Caring for Kenneth and his family is the Shelley Funeral Chapel in Little Falls.

Kenneth was born on November 19, 1935, to the late Merritt and Jeanette (Like) Lowe in Belle Prairie Township, MN. He was the youngest of their 4 boys. Kenneth attended the one-room school house, District 28, that was across the Platte River from their family farm south of Freedhem, MN. He graduated from Little Falls High School in 1953. At the age of 24, Kenneth served two years in the US Army. During this time, he was stationed in New Ulm, Germany, driving Jeeps for various officers. He earned the rank of SP4 before his honorable discharge. Kenneth returned home to what he loved best, and farmed the original homestead with his brother Ronald, raising dairy cows and hogs. He retired from farming at the age of 72, but continued to live on the farm until 2021. At that time, he moved to Little Falls to be closer to family during covid. Kenneth enjoyed reading and playing card and dice games with his family.

Kenneth is survived by his brother, Donald; sister-in-law, Edith Lowe; and 9

nieces and nephews as well as many great-nieces and nephews.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Merritt and Jeanette; brothers, Ronald and Keith; and sister-in-law, Doris Lowe.
