



Kenneth K.J. Lambrecht

April 22, 1947 - November 4, 2010

Kenneth Lloyd (K.J.) Lambrecht, 63 year old resident of Swanville, MN, passed away Thursday, Nov. 4, 2010 at Clearwater County Memorial Hospital in Bagley, MN. A Funeral Service for Kenneth Lambrecht will be held at 11AM, Monday, November 8, 2010 at St. Peter's Lutheran Church in Swanville, MN, with Pastor John Grein officiating. Burial will be at St. Peter's Cemetery in Swanville. Friends may call from 3-8PM Sunday and one hour prior to the service on Monday at the church.

Kenneth Lloyd "K.J." Lambrecht was born on April 22, 1947 in Little Falls, Minnesota to Adelbert & Laura (Nordin) Lambrecht. He was baptized and confirmed at St. Peter's Lutheran Church. K.J. graduated from Swanville High School in 1966 then was drafted into the U.S. Army and served overseas in Vietnam. He was united in marriage to Cheryl Skinner on March 16, 1968 at St. Peter's Lutheran Church in Swanville. The couple lived in Salinas, California while K.J. was still on active service. He was honorably discharged in August of 1968. The couple moved back to the Burtrum area and K.J. worked various jobs; milk truck driving, mechanic, then in the early 80' he began hauling livestock for Hatton Trucking Company. In 1991 he purchased his first semi-truck and started K.J. Lambrecht Trucking. In 1996 K.J. added Lambrecht Livestock Trucking with his son Jeff. Together they also operated Lambrecht Trailer Cleanout. Well known for his sense of humor, K.J. greeted everyone with "Hey Kid". His passion was spending time with his grandkids who often accompanied him on his loads.
