Lawrence W. Maciej, age 86, resident of Swanville, MN, passed away Friday, May 16, 2008 at St. Otto's Care Center in Little Falls. A Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 11:00 AM on Monday, May 19, 2008 at St. John's Catholic Church in Swanville with Father Ronald Dockendorf officiating.
