Leonard Schubert, 91-year-old resident of Wahkon, MN passed away on December 13, 2017 at the VA Medical Center in St. Cloud, MN. Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 10:30 AM on Monday, December 18, 2017 at Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Wahkon, MN with Father Greg Poser, OSC officiating. Visitation will be held 1 hour prior to Mass at Church. Interment will be in Sacred Heart Catholic Cemetery. Arrangements are with the Shelley Funeral Chapel of Onamia.

Leonard Joseph Schubert was born on March 4, 1926, in Isle, Minnesota to Jane (McGraw) and Edward Schubert, the fourth of seven children. Leonard grew up on a farm south of Wahkon, Minnesota during the Great Depression where he learned the value of hard work and the importance of family. He graduated from Isle High School in 1944. Leonard is a World War II Veteran as he enlisted in the United States Army on May 11, 1945, and received an Honorable Discharge from active duty on November 22, 1946. He returned to Wahkon to work on the family farm with his father and two brothers, Vincent and Phillip. On September 27, 1952, he was united in marriage to Margaret Berthiaume in Minneapolis, Minnesota. Leonard and Margaret had been married 65 years at the time of his death. Leonard and Margaret began their married life by purchasing a house and land adjoining the family farm. He operated the dairy farm in addition to raising sheep, pigs, and chickens. Leonard and his brother Phillip also did commercial silo filling for other farmers in the area. Leonard was a very kind man and cherished time spent

with his wife, children, grandchildren, and great-grandchildren. He enjoyed deer hunting, snowmobiling, and going to farm auctions with his brother Vincent. In retirement, Leonard enjoyed watching the Twins, Vikings, and Timberwolves. In addition, he liked observing the neighbors' farming operations and tending to his four acre lawn. Leonard will be greatly missed by all.

Leonard is survived by his loving wife, Margaret of Wahkon; children, Raydene (Bradley) Hammerberg of St. Cloud, LeAnne Schubert of Onamia, Jerome (Natalie) Schubert of Rice, Thomas (Janine) Schubert of Byron and Daniel Schubert of Eden Prairie; brother, Phillip Schubert; sisters, Mary Schubert and Alice (Raymond) Auer; nine grandchildren and six great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his parents and brothers: Vincent, Raymond and Lawrence.
