Linda Stumpf, 64, a resident of Bowlus, died February 23, 2011, at her home.

Linda was born on November 12, 1946 in Little Falls, MN to the late Clarence and Shirley (Nergie) Stumpf. She attended and graduated from John H. Linda was never an idle woman. Her hobbies included tending to her greenhouse and gardens, painting, sculpting, drawing, and home repair. She was a voracious reader. Linda was a renaissance woman; it seemed like there was no task that she couldn't accomplish. She was greatly loved and will be dearly missed.
