Lloyd 'Hooey' Garrison, 79 year old resident of Little Falls, MN passed away Wednesday, January 13, 2010 at the St. Cloud Hospital in St. Cloud, MN. Funeral Service for Lloyd 'Hooey' Garrison will be at 11:30 AM, Saturday, January 16, 2010 at the Shelley Funeral Chapel in Little Falls, MN, with Father Nicholas Landsberger officiating. Burial will be at a later date at St. Adalberts Cemetery in Little Falls. Friends may call from 10 to 11:30 AM Saturday in our chapel. Lloyd Alfred Garrison was born on June 8, 1930 in Cushing, MN to the late Henry and Mary (Sharon) Garrison. Given the nickname of 'Hooey', he enlisted in the US Army and served overseas in West Germany during the Korean Conflict. Lloyd 'Hooey' Garrison was united in marriage to Ann Balaski on December 13, 1961 at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Little Falls, MN. Together they made their home in Little Falls. 'Hooey' transported boats all over the continental United States for Larson Boat works, working for them for 35 years until retiring in 1992. He enjoyed watching the Vikings and Twins on TV, playing games of cribbage for money (he usually won), trips to the casino, deer hunting and fishing. 'Hooey' was a long time member of St. Mary's Church, the Moose Lodge, American Legion and V.F.W. Posts here in Little Falls.

'Hooey' is survived by his wife, Ann; sons, Charlie Garrison of Oakdale, MN, and Patrick Garrison of Rochester, MN; daughter, Judy Stroschein of Little

Falls, MN; grandchildren, Todd Doble and his friend Angie Bujarski, Kayla, William, Tyler, Abby, and Jack Garrison; great grandchildren, Natasha, Halee, Tia, and Noah Doble, and Cody Bujarski; many nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his parents, five brothers and four sisters.
