



## Lucille Margaret Brummer

Lucille Brummer, 89-year-old resident of Hillman, MN passed away on Friday, June 29, 2018 at the Mille Lacs Health System Long Term Care Center in Onamia, MN. A Funeral Mass will be held at 11 A.M. on Tuesday, July 3, 2018 at Holy Family Catholic Church, Bulldog Lake, MN. Visitation with family and friends will be held 1 hour prior to Mass at Church. She was an avid book reader, and unfortunately, her body gave out well before her mind ever would have. Lucille was quick-witted and had a special love for her friends and her family. She felt joy in sitting on the floor and playing with her grandchildren and later her

great-grandchildren.
