Lucy Becker, 77 year old resident of Pierz, MN, passed away Sunday, December 12, 2010 at her residence. After school Lucy went to work in the cities for Scott Atwater and roomed with Doris Hoffman. Later she returned home and was united in marriage to Norb Becker on June 17, 1952 in Lastrup, MN. They farmed North of Harding, MN and later moved to the home farm west of Pierz, MN where they raised their six children, Gordy, Lois, Shari, Jim, Jerry, and Danny. They built up a Grade A dairy farm and owned and operated the Red Rooster in Genola. Lucy and Norb later built a home on Pierz Fish Lake where Lucy lived till her passing. Lucy also worked for Munsingwear in Little Falls for 17 years until they closed in 1982. She then

took a course to be a Certified Nursing Assistant and worked for 6 years at St. Mary's Villa in Pierz, MN. Lucy then went to work at St. Otto's Care Center in Little Falls until health problems made her retire over the phone in 2004. She enjoyed working with her beautiful flowers, watching the birds, and all the excitement that took place on the lake. Lucy was dearly loved and will be greatly missed by many.
