April 2, 1917 - March 28, 2015

Margaret Mary May, 97 year old resident of Little Falls, MN, passed away Saturday, March 28, 2015, at Bridgeway Estates in Little Falls, MN. A Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 12 noon on Friday, April 17, 2015 at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Little Falls, MN, with Father Joe Herzing officiating and Father Nicholas Landsberger con-celebrating. Visitation will be from 10 AM until 12 noon on Friday at the church. Christian Mothers will pray the Rosary at 11 AM Friday.

Margaret was born on April 2, 1917 at home in Bellevue Township, Morrison County, Minnesota, to the late Paul and Eleanor (Riedner) Rudek. As a young child, Margaret helped care for her 10 younger brothers and sisters on the family's farm. She attended St. Francis High School, but returned to the family farm to help her mother with her brothers and sisters. Margaret was employed for many years at the Munsingwear factory in Little Falls and then with the Lutheran Care Center, from which she retired. She was united in marriage to John May on October 3, 1940 at St. James Catholic Church in Randall, MN. The couple had seven children. Margaret was an exceptional caregiver and mother, caring for all 6 children, numerous grandchildren, husband John during his disability, and volunteering at the Lutheran Care Center well into her nineties. One of Margaret's favorite pastimes was going to the nursing home and visiting the "Old Folks". She also enjoyed sewing and gardening, both flowers and vegetables, and then canning and freezing the produce.

Margaret was an excellent cook, and the family plans on combining all her recipes into a cookbook. She took great pride in maintaining her own home and being self sufficient. It wasn't until reaching the age of 95 that she moved into Bridgeway Estates, and then she still did many things herself. Margaret was also a member of Christian Mothers and CMTEC 129.

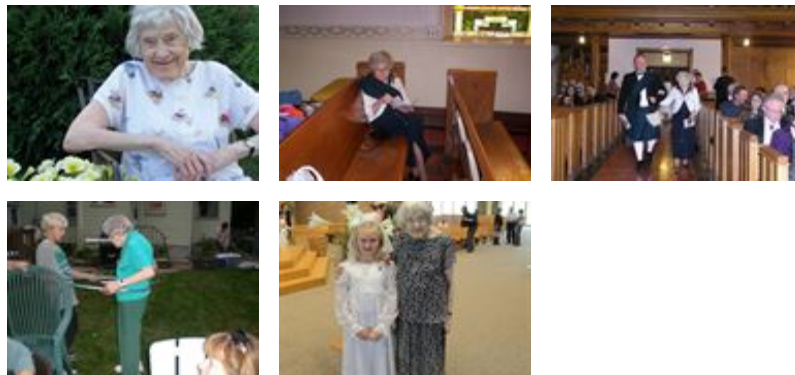

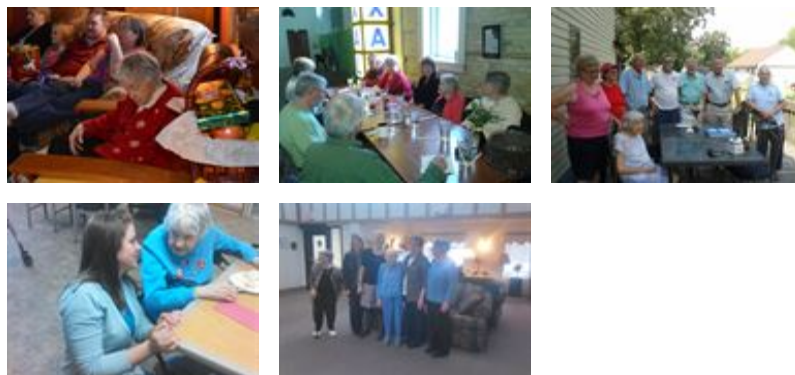
