Margaret M. Gammon, 84 year old resident of Little Falls, MN passed away Saturday, January 28, 2012 at St. Gabriel's Hospital in Little Falls. A Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 11:30 A.M. on Wednesday, February 1, 2012 at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Little Falls with Father Nicholas Landsberger officiating. Burial will be at the Minnesota State Veterans Cemetery north of Little Falls.
