Marian was born on November 5, 1919 in Woonsocket, South Dakota. She studied at the country school in Woonsocket and later attended a women's vocational high school in White Lake, SD where she learned her love of woodworking. After high school, her family moved to McGrath, MN where she met and fell in love with Edwin Ruud. She was united to him in marriage on June 23, 1944 in Minneapolis, MN. They lived in Minneapolis until moving to Hopkins in 1956. They raised 2 children, Steven and Gail. Marian devoted her life to taking care of her family. In Hopkins, she was active at Shepard of the Hills Lutheran Church and was also very involved in the Girl Scouts. In 1969, the couple retired and moved to Isle, MN. In Isle, Marian continued to be involved at Holden Lutheran Church by teaching Sunday school, singing in the church choir, and participating in the Ladies Aid. Her husband, Edwin passed away in 1992. In 1995 she moved to Little Falls where she resided at the Buckman Apartments and spent much of her time with her friends, children, grandchildren and great grandchildren.

Marian was a woman of strong Christian faith who had the heart of a servant. She was also known by her family to be an excellent cook and a maker of fine pies. She was a strong and loving woman and will be greatly missed by her family and friends.
