August 26, 1924 - April 20, 2009

Margie (Smude) Boser was born on August 26, 1924 in Pine Center, Minnesota to Joseph and Mary (Kaminski) Smude. Later her family moved to Onamia where she attended school until the death of her mother. She then helped to raise her younger siblings; Marilyn, Marliss, Jerome, and Jimmy. As a young woman Margie worked as a waitress. She married Clarence Boser in 1943 in the state of Virginia. When Clarence left for the African Campaign during WWII, Margie returned to Onamia and resumed waitressing. Also during this time Margie was instrumental in raising her own sons, two granddaughters, and great grandchildren. In 2002 Margie sold the farm and moved into an apartment in Onamia. She was happy there and enjoyed treating her neighbors to some of her cooking and baking. Margie enjoyed cooking, baking, collecting recipes, and growing plants. Her home was always open to her family and friends. She loved to make sure everyone was well fed and when her sons, grandchildren, and great grandchildren came to her home, the refrigerator was one of the first places they checked for some goodies!! She loved to reminisce about her childhood on her rides to Pine

Center, Bulldog Lake, Pierz, and Little Falls with her brother Jerome and sister Marliss. She and Marliss had great fun going to Isle for their haircuts, shopping, and stopping in Wahkon for chicken. Margie and her niece Bonnie had fun camping and taking several short trips together.
