Marsha Skoog, beloved daughter, sister, wife, mother, devoted educator, and active member of the Baha'i Community, passed away peacefully the morning of April 27th 2024 surrounded by family at the age of 62. A Committal Service will be held 11:30 AM on Tuesday, April 30, 2024, at Mount Pleasant Cemetery in Onamia, MN, with fellowship to follow at Bethany Lutheran Church in Onamia. Marsha was born on February 4, 1962, in Minneapolis, Minnesota, to Norma (Huffman) and Lloyd Chitwood. She was a graduate of Pine River High School in 1980.
