Martha R. Nornberg, 96 year old resident of Little Falls, MN, passed away on Wednesday, May 19, 2021, at the St. Gabriel's Hospital in Little Falls, MN. A funeral service will be held on Sunday, May 23, 2021, at First United Church in Little Falls, at 3:00 P.M., with Pastor Tony Romaine officiating.
