Mary "Jo" was born on May 28, 1922 in Swan River, Manitoba, Canada to the late John & Mary Fuller. The family immigrated to the United States when Jo was a young girl. They lived in St. Paul, MN for a few years.

The Fuller family purchased a dairy farm near Randall, MN where Mary 'Jo' grew up, attended country school and later, Little Falls High School. She was united in marriage to Julius O. Rebeschke on October 8, 1951 in New Hampton, IA. The couple owned and operated a dairy farm in Parker Township, Morrison County until retiring in 1968 and moved to Randall, MN. In 2002, the couple moved to Little Falls because of declining health. Mary 'Jo' was a very talented, self taught woman. She learned how to quilt and became known as a seamstress extraordinaire. She also learned how to paint, using acrylic and watercolor paints to capture the beauty of flowers, family pets and whatever caught her fancy. She was an original 'green' gardener with two large vegetable and flower gardens. Mary 'Jo' was an especially devoted wife, mother and friend. She enjoyed the company of everyone. She was a faithful member of Bethel Lutheran Church in Little Falls. When she was able, Jo shared her talents with others by singing in the church choir and volunteering at church and school.
