Maurice P. Przybilla, age 74, a resident of Pierz, MN passed away Friday, May 15, 2009 at the Pierz Villa in Pierz, MN. A Mass of Christian Burial will be at 10:30 AM on Tuesday, May 19, 2009 at St. Joseph Catholic Church in Pierz, MN with Father Kenneth Brenny officiating. Burial will be at Minnesota State Veterans Cemetery north of Little Falls, MN. Visitation will be from 4 to 8 PM Monday, May 18, 2009 at Shelley-Virnig Funeral Chapel in Pierz and from 9:30 to 10:30 AM Tuesday at the funeral chapel. Parish Prayers will be held at 7 PM followed by Knights of Columbus Office of the Dead Service at 7:30 PM. Military Rites will be conducted by the Camp Ripley Honor Guard.
