Michael J. Dolney, Jr., 45 year old resident of Randall, MN passed away Saturday, October 25, 2014 as a result of a motorcycle accident. Funeral services will be held at 11 A.M. on Thursday, October 30, 2014 at the Living Hope Assembly of God Church in Little Falls, MN with Pastor Keith Thompson officiating. Burial will be at Oakland Cemetery in Little Falls, MN. Visitation will be from 4-8 P.M. on Wednesday at the Shelley Funeral Chapel in Little Falls and 10:00 –11:00 A.M. on Thursday at the church.

Michael was born on October 8, 1969 in Little Falls, Minnesota to Michael Sr. and Bernadette (Harris) Dolney. He attended school in Little Falls where he participated in football and band and graduated from Little Falls High School with the Class of 1988. Harley Davidson rider, and enjoyed custom building motorcycles as well. Michael enjoyed spending time with his family (especially his young nieces and cousins) and friends, and will be dearly missed by all.

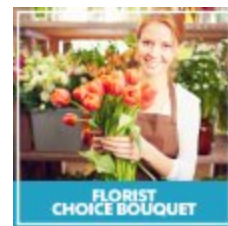

Mike was my best friend in this entire cruel, tragic, yet wonderful world. That friendship began in the first grade taking turns farting in a "Lincoln Log" can. Oh how we laughed. Those two themes; bodily sounds & laughter would continue throughout life's highway together. In fact, I know I will never laugh in the way Mike and I shared it... again.

In elementary school, Mike inadvertently showed his intelligence and compassion. He was the one who; once a lesson was taught, (if he didn't already somehow know it), would go around helping anyone having problems. He would continue to help me until graduation.

Throughout his adolescence, I would consider him an extreme introvert. It wasn't until his first scooter crash (when he bumped his head), the rest of the world had a chance to see that wonderful man. He came out of it a social butterfly. Bernie I'm not sure if you recall, but when he couldn't even remember his own address in the hospital, he still scored in the genius level on all the tests the physiologist was giving.

Deb and I acquired a dog from the local pound who turned out to have a real big personality. A few years in he bit the neighbor boy. They asked that I would have him put down. So... in the cover of darkness, Mike picked him up (Scruggs) and took him in as his own. This was normal for Mike. If there was a three legged, blind, psychotic or whatever type animal nobody could care for ~ it always had a home with Mike.

In our teens and twenties we'd loiter in fast food joints, gas stations or wherever like mad. Mike would drink about four gallons of pop while we chewed Cope and spit in cups. It was these times our dreams were being built. I would say getting scooters and living free from societies rules (written and unwritten) was A.#.1. Looking back

I'd say we came mighty close to achieving the lifestyle.

With Mikes adamancy, we started a MC club. I know I've killed a lot of brain cells but it feels as though we ran the club a couple yrs. before the "Hells Angels" had a problem. Mike and I were pretty much forced into a meeting at the Angels club house. I remember being nervous walking in, then small talk to the extreme, followed by the start of the meeting. Inside the clubhouse there were at least three other "Outlaw" clubs in attendance. Along with (so it seemed), a U.S. Marshall and State Judge. When it came to the issue of "Freetrappers" Mike and I were escorted outside. Surrounded by fifteen Angels (and concertina wire) showing their display of testosterone, Mike was his true normal self. He completely pissed off one of the die hard assholes, but had the rest hanging on his every word.

We we were led back in and they made it aware that the vote was to abolish our club. Mike refuted the decision with logic and they could not easily respond. Another leader steps up to try and debate... Sorry, Mikey just respectfully made you all look like complete clowns. We walked out able to keep our "Rags", but no more club.

When Mike became sole proprietor and CEO of "Freetrappers Muzzleloading" I knew he would be happy the rest of his life. I also knew it would be rather hard for him to actually make any money doing it. You see, if a customer were to buy say.. \$10 worth of merchandise, Mikey would give him at least another \$10 worth of stuff. I'm sure that continued right up until his last sale. He was just so happy to make someone else happy! I just remembered his store hours sign on the door: "Open anytime now, until sometime after that". (I can picture him giggling and cussing trying to put those little white letters in their perspective spot with his sausage fingers).

Many of us talk the talk about being a truly good person. Mike most certainly walked the walk. How amazingly privileged we all were to have spent any amount of time with this giant of an individual. I myself will love and miss him till the day my road ends. He was

more than a man. He was... "A MOUNTAIN MAN"!

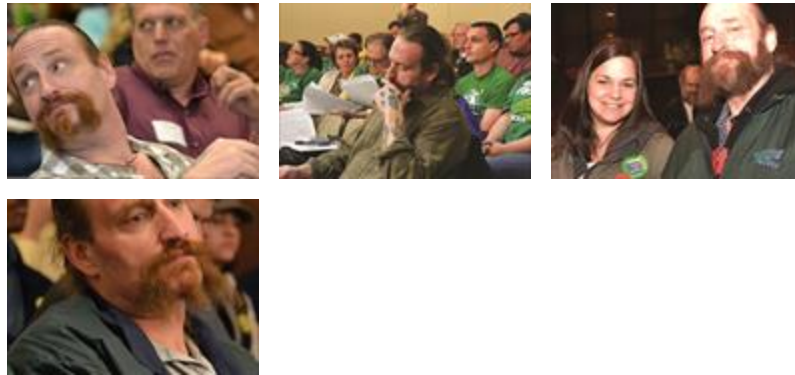

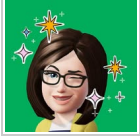

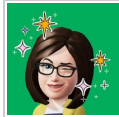
