Mildred "Millie" Cook, 95 year old resident of Little Falls, MN passed away Thursday, March 28, 2019 at St. Otto's Care Center in Little Falls, MN. A Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 11:30 AM on Thursday, April 4, 2019 at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Little Falls, with Father Ben Kociemba officiating, with a visitation one hour prior to the Mass at church. Burial will be at the Minnesota State Veterans Cemetery north of Little Falls.

Mildred Marie Wuelling was born on February 19, 1924 in Alton, IL, to the late Henry and Helen (Borgmeyer) Wuelling. She grew up in St. Louis, MO, and graduated from Wellston High School. Millie was united in marriage to Charles "Chuck" Cook on January 26, 1946 at Notre Dame Catholic Church in St. Louis. They moved to Little Falls, MN, where Chuck grew up, in 1946. Millie worked as a retail clerk at two stores in Little Falls, the Leader store and Lad and Lassie. Her hobbies included sewing, crocheting and gardening. She was a member of the Red Hats, Lindy Ladies, and the Slick Chick groups, and participated in the Highway Cleanups.

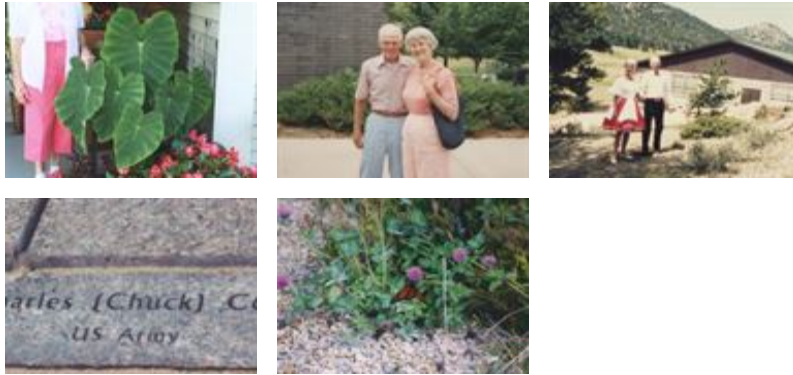
