Mildred Bertha Clear was born on September 8, 1918 in Grey Eagle, MN to the late James and Edith (Osborn) Clear. She met and married Carl Lekberg on June 7, 1938 in Grey Eagle. Together they farmed in the Swanville area. In 1942, they moved to Seattle, WA and helped in the war effort; Carl worked in the ship yards and Mildred was a “Rosie the Riveter” at Boeing Company. In 1945, they moved back to Swanville and purchased a farm. Moving back to Seattle in 1948, Carl worked at Boeing until 1971, when he retired and they came back to Swanville. Mildred enjoyed working in her garden, as well as cooking and baking. She looked forward to visiting with family and friends and playing cards. Mildred was an active member at Community Covenant Church, often helping out in the kitchen.

Mildred is survived by her son Ron (Kim) Lekberg of Poulsbo, WA; daughters, Carol (Jim) Larson of Burtrum, MN, and Margie (John) Olson of Swanville, MN; brother George Clear of Grey Eagle, MN; 12 grandchildren, 29 great grandchildren, and 3 great great grandchildren.
