Norman H. Wuellner, 85 year old resident of Little Falls, MN passed away Friday, April 27, 2012 at his home in Little Falls. A Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 10:30 A.M. on Tuesday, May 1, 2012 at Our Lady Of Lourdes Catholic Church in Little Falls, MN with Father Mark Innocenti officiating. Burial will be at the Minnesota State Veterans Cemetery north of Little Falls. Visitation will be from 4 to 8 PM on Monday, April 30th at the Shelley Funeral Chapel in Little Falls and from 9 to 10 AM on Tuesday at the Shelley Funeral Chapel. A Parish Prayer Service will be held at 6 PM on Monday at the funeral chapel.

Norman was born on September 28, 1926 in Agram Township, Morrison County to the late Otto and Margaret (Hoheisel) Wuellner. He grew up and attended country school in Agram Township until the 8th grade. Norman honorably served in the U.S. Army for 5 years doing tours during WWII and the Korean War and was honorably discharged as a Sergeant. He was united in marriage to Mary Zyvoloski of April 11, 1953 on a Military Base in California. Norman worked various jobs through out his life and was a very hard worker. Missing work was never an option for him and he finally retired at age 80. He was an avid sports fan, always watching the Minnesota Twins and the Minnesota Vikings. Norman also enjoyed taking his grandchildren hunting and fishing, and later in life they were the ones taking him hunting and fishing. The last couple years he participated in several Disabled Veteran deer hunts at Camp Ripley. Norman enjoyed taking trips to the casino, was an excellent

card player, and also a good horseshoe player. In his later years Norman spent his time building birdhouses and watching the birds in his yard. Norman always had a good appetite and he also loved to cook. His famous chicken and dressing will be forever missed by his family. Norman was one of a kind, always having that perfect one-liner and a heart of gold. He was dearly loved by his entire family and will be greatly missed.
