Norris Anderson was born April 26, 1927 in Little Falls, Minnesota to the late Andrew and Nellie Anderson. He grew up in Little Falls until enlisting in the Navy in 1944. Norris proudly served during World War II as a Fire Control man third class (FC3) on various ships in the South Pacific. He was honorably discharged in 1948. After returning to Minnesota, he attended Dunwoody Institute to become a brick layer. After working on various schools, churches, and other projects in Minnesota, Norris returned to Little Falls. He married Betty West in 1960. Norris built over fifty houses in the area throughout the 60's, 70's, and 80's before retiring in 1989. He enjoyed many years of hunting, fishing, and visiting the casino with Betty. Norris is survived by his loving wife, Betty; son, Jon (Lisa) Anderson of Rochester, MN; step-daughter, Denise (Ernie) Hegna of Royalton, MN; step-son Richard (Becky) Mausolf of Brainerd, MN; eight grandchildren and three great-grandchildren.
