



## Patricia A. Urbanski

May 26, 1938 - July 23, 2009

Patricia Ann Haley was born on May 26, 1938 in Bird Island, Minnesota to the late Thomas and Mildred (Driscoll) Haley. She grew up on several different farms in southern Minnesota. Patricia attended nursing school at St. Scholastica, graduating as a registered nurse. She enlisted in the Army in 1958 and eventually served overseas in a MASH unit in Korea. She was honorably discharged in 1961 as a 2nd lieutenant. Patricia was united in marriage to James Arthur Urbanski on June 8, 1963 at St. Bridget's Catholic Church in Minneapolis. Together they made their home in Little Falls where James taught in the public schools and Patricia continued her nursing at St. Gabriel's Hospital. She retired from St. Gabriels in 1976 and with her husband, opened up a trophy business in Little Falls, where she handled much of the engraving. After James passed away in 2003, Patricia continued to operate the business until 2007. She was one of the first ones involved with the Little Falls Craft Fair, serving many years on the organizing committee. With her husband James, they started up the No Tap Bowling Tournament. She handled the funeral luncheon duties for many years at St. Mary's Church and remained active in her community. Patricia enjoyed playing bridge and blackjack, bingo, bowling, and spending time with family and friends. She was a longtime member of St. Mary's Church, Little Falls American Legion Post 46 and V.F.W. Post 1112 Ladies Auxillaries.

Patricia is survived by her children, Robert Urbanski of Panama City, FL, Jim (Karin) Urbanski of St. Cloud, MN, Peggy Urbanski of Little Falls, MN, and
