Patrick "Pat" J. Kalahar, 81 year old resident of Little Falls, MN passed away Tuesday, January 25, 2022 at his home in Little Falls. A Funeral Service will be 1:00 PM on Friday, February 4, 2022, at the Camp Ripley Chapel inside the gates of Camp Ripley with Bob Mueller officiating. Burial will be at the Minnesota State Veteran's Cemetery north of Little Falls. Visitation will be two hours prior to the service on Friday at the Camp Ripley Chapel. Riverwood Drive and found strength in his faith.

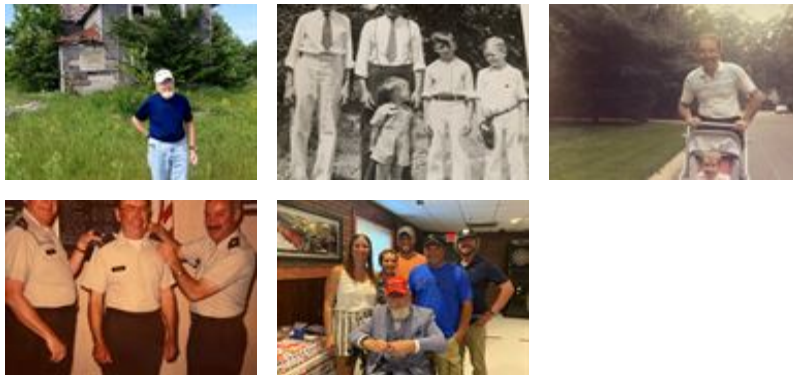
