Rachel was born September 24, 1931 in Little Falls, MN to the late Clarence & Emma Taylor. She grew up in Randall, MN and attended elementary school. She then attended Little Falls High School and graduated in 1949. Rachel was united in marriage to Elmer J. Beto on May 13, 1950 at St. Peter's Lutheran Church in Randall, MN. She worked as a waitress for a few years at the VFW Club and later at the Maid Rite Café in Little Falls. Rachel then became employed at the U.S. Post Office as a clerk and later, she became the first female mail carrier in Little Falls. After 16 years, she became disabled and retired. Rachel enjoyed bowling, feeding and watching birds, playing cards, small game hunting and was part of the Wednesday coffee club at the Canteen. She was a member of Zion Lutheran Church, Little Falls American Legion Auxiliary Post #46 & VFW Auxiliary Post #1112.

Rachel E. Beto is survived by her sons, Douglas (Donna) Beto of Little Falls and Duane Beto of Little Falls; a daughter, Lella Beto of Minneapolis, MN; grandchildren, Kelley, Holly, Kaity and Waylon Beto.

Rachel was preceded in death by her parents; husband, Elmer; brothers, Harlan, Willard, Orvin and Laurel Taylor.
