Randy David Englehart, 69 year old resident of Cushing, MN, passed away peacefully on Monday, March 11, 2024 at his residence. Randy David Englehart was born on October 26, 1954 in Little Falls, MN, to the late John and Jeanette (Heinz) Englehart. He graduated from Little Falls High School in 1973. Randy worked as an equipment operator in constructing roads throughout the Dakota's and Minnesota. Randy and Delores would travel down to Texas and stayed in a trailer home last 7 years, wintering in Texas.

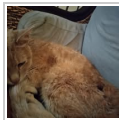

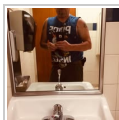
