Raymond was born May 3, 1931 in Little Falls, MN to the late Aloys and Edna (Maleski) Lucking. He entered into the U.S Army on February 16, 1954 and was honorably discharged on February 15, 1956. Ray was united in marriage to Mary Ann Hoheisel on May 30, 1961 at St. Joseph's Catholic Church in Pierz, MN. Ray farmed near Pierz and worked at the Pierz Creamery. He then began working at R&S Farm Repair before going into business for himself operating Ray's Make-Fix until he retired in 2001. Ray will always be remembered as the poet, "Rhymin Ray" and the weatherman for the "Genola Freeway". Everyone knew Ray's familiar knock on their business door when he was about to enter. Ray was a member of St. Joseph's Catholic Church, American Legion Post #341, and Pierz Knights of Columbus.

Ray is survived by wife, Mary Ann Lucking of Pierz, MN; brother, Art Lucking of Big Lake, MN; close nephews, Mike (Colleen) Lucking of Pierz, MN, and Kurt (Joelle) Lucking of Genola, MN; many in-laws, and nieces and nephews.
