Reinhard George Langer, 94 year old resident of Pierz, MN, passed away peacefully on Wednesday, April 15, 2015 at the Pierz Villa surrounded by his family. A Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 11:00 A.M. on Monday, April 20, 2015 at St. Joseph's Catholic Church in Pierz, MN with Father Gerald Dalseth officiating and Father Kenneth Popp con-celebrating. Burial will take place at St. Joseph's Parish Cemetery in Pierz, MN.
