Reuben Oscar Hokanson was born on July 26, 1916 in Little Elk Township, Todd County, MN to the late Karl Henry and Anna (Lager) Hokanson. He grew up and attended school in Little Elk Township and worked on the family farm until purchasing his own land nearby. Reuben was united in marriage to Gladys Sharon on October 12, 1940 at Zion Lutheran Church in Little Elk Township, MN. The couple made their home west of Randall, MN, where together they farmed and raised their family. They operated the farm until 1979, when they sold and moved into their present home north of Little Falls in Belle Prairie Township. After retiring from farming, Reuben kept busy painting houses. He also worked at the Morrison County fairgrounds for several years doing maintenance. Reuben enjoyed traveling, hunting (for 70 years), trapping, cross-country skiing (until recently), gardening, and reminiscing about old times. He served on the District 151 school board, Randall Creamery board, and the Zion Lutheran Church council in Browerville, MN.
