Richard 'Dick' Schultz, 77 year old resident of Cushing, MN, formerly of Little Falls, passed away Wednesday (Jan. 13) at the St. Cloud Hospital. Mass of Christian Burial will be held Saturday, January 16, at 11:00 A.M. at St. Michael's Catholic Church in Motley, MN with Rev. Ronald Schmelzer officiating. Burial will be in the spring at the Minnesota State Veteran's Cemetery. Richard 'Dick' Schultz was born February 19, 1932 in Peterson, Iowa to the late Ray & Alice 'Frasier' Schultz. He grew up in Peterson, IA and graduated from high school. Dick then attended Brown Institute in Minneapolis, MN and completed the course as a electronic technician. He entered the US Navy in 1949 and was honorably discharge due to an injury in 1950. Dick was united in marriage to Nancy L. Anderson on August 23, 1952 at St. Frances Xavier Catholic Church in Little Falls, MN. Dick was employed by Minnesota Power for 33 years. He worked as a sub-station repair foremen until retiring in 1993. In 1988, Dick and his sons built their retirement home on Lake Alexander near Cushing, MN where they have resided since retirement. Dick was a superb handyman. There was nothing he couldn't fix, repair or build. He enjoyed golfing in the Little Falls, Pierz and later at Pine Ridge golf men's league. He was a member of St. Michael's Catholic Church in Motley, MN and the Little

Falls American Legion Post #46.
