Richard Posch, a retired BNSF Machinist, life-long resident of Bowlus, MN, died unexpectedly at the St. Cloud Hospital on December 27, 2020, at the age of 68. Richard passed away with his children by his side. A mass of Christian Burial will be held on Monday, January 4, 2021, at St. Stanislaus Catholic Church in Bowlus, MN, at 11:00 A.M. with Father Roger Klassen officiating.
