

## Robert "Bob" J. Nennig

December 14, 1935 - January 27, 2019

Robert "Bob" J. Nennig, 83 year old resident of Little Falls, MN, passed away on Sunday, January 27, 2019 at St. Otto's Care Center. A Mass of Christian Burial will be at 11:30 AM on Friday, February 1, 2019, at St. Mary's Catholic Church, Little Falls, MN with Father Ben Kociemba officiating and Father Stan Wieser concelebrating. Burial will be in the Parish Cemetery. Visitation will be one hour prior to the service on Friday at the church. Knights of Columbus prayers at 11 AM Friday morning.

Robert was born in rural Wilkin County, MN on December 14, 1935, to Albert and Loretta (Tryba) Nennig. Bob helped on the family farm. He was drafted into the military after high school and later worked for the Great Northern Railroad and on a ranch by Steele, ND. Bob then owned and operated a filling station in Fairmont, ND, where he also did mechanic work. He married Frances "Fran" Nennig on May 10, 1960, and together they raised their two children, Victor and Sallie. Bob worked at Monahan's in Little Falls had a farm near Camp Ripley, then later moved west of Little Falls on a dairy farm. After his dairy farm, Bob opened R & V's Repair in Little Falls with his son Victor. Bob was a member of St. Mary's Church in Little Falls. He was a Grand Knight and active member of The Knights of Columbus. His greatest hobby was restoring old tractors and he was an active member of the Two Cylinder Club in Little Falls.

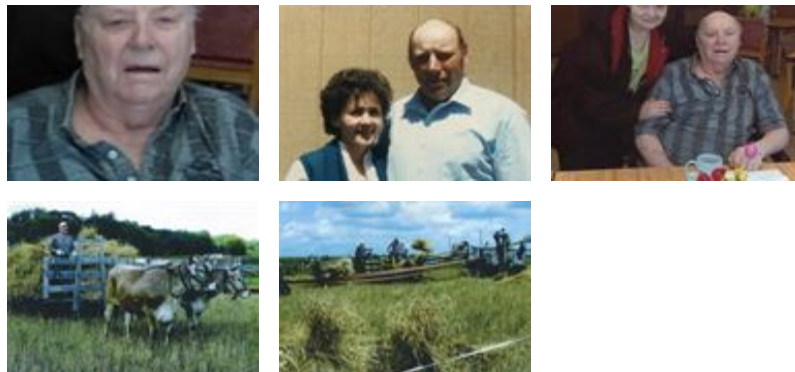
