Robert H. Reith, 51 year old resident of Randall, MN, passed away on Thursday, March 2, 2023 in Little Falls, MN. He also spent a lot of time riding his Polaris four-wheeler all around the farm. Robert really loved music, singing and dancing. He especially liked the song International Harvester and wearing his International Harvester hat. After high school, he got a job at Employment Enterprise in Little Falls and worked there for 31 years. There he was able to work out in the communities. He loved his job and all his friends. On

December 5, 2022, he moved into Jo-Jo's Adult Foster Home in Little Falls and loved the staff and all the residents. He was a member of St. John the Baptist Catholic Church in Swanville and also was a member of the Knights of Columbus. On March 2, 2023, he passed away at Jo-Jo Adult Foster Home with his parents, special friends and wonderful staff by his side.
