



Robert A. "Art" Lindborg

March 24, 1920 - April 26, 2011

Robert Arthur Lindborg was born March 24, 1920 to Swedish immigrants, Robert and Selma Lindborg on their farm west of Little Falls, MN. He attended country grade schools in Culdrum and Parker Townships and Little Falls High School. In 1941, Robert graduated from the University of Minnesota School of Agriculture in St. Paul, MN with a degree in Animal Husbandry. He was united in marriage to Hazel G. Nelson of December 29, 1943 at the Darling Lutheran Church in Darling, MN. Robert was a successful farmer of registered Holstein cows and was declared 1966's Minnesota Farm Family of the year. Robert also received awards for the top producing herd in Minnesota, along with individual cows breaking state records in milk production. Throughout the years, the Lindborg dairy cattle were exhibited at various local, regional and state shows, winning numerous awards. He was a member of the National Holstein Frisian Association; a member of the Dairy Herd Improvement Association (DHIA) and the Central Minnesota Holstein Association where he served as Morrison County secretary. Robert was also a charter fifty year member of Rural Youth.

Following their retirement, the couple traveled extensively throughout the United State, Canada, Sweden, Norway, Finland, Mexicao and Japan. Robert was part of the Swedish Mission Covenant Church in Culdrum Township until it disbanded. He then became a member of First Baptist Church in Little Falls where he served on the church board. He was currently attending Grace Covenant Church and was active in its Seniors Group.

Robert A. Lindborg is survived by his wife, Hazel; son, Robert (Bob) Lindborg of Little Falls, MN; Shirley (Gordon) Hove of St. Cloud, MN; grandchildren, Erik (Katherine) Hove of Chicago, IL and Krista (Steven) Windingland of Chanhassen, MN great grandsons, Wesley and Micah Windingland and nieces and nephews.

Robert was preceded in death by his parents; sisters, Violet Esselstrom and Dorothy Titrud; a niece, Rebecca (Titrud) Crain and nephew, Dr. Dennis Esselstrom.
