August 23, 1927 - May 28, 2007

Russell was born on August 23, 1927 in St. Paul, MN to the late Iver and Maude Sod. He graduated in 1945 from Little Falls High School. He attended Dunwoody Institute for two years earning his machinist degree. In February of 1948 Russell joined the US Navy. Russell was stationed on the USS Enterprise. After 20 years of service he retired in March of 1971 and moved to Washington state. Russell worked as a stationary engineer, for 15 years at Retsil Veterans Home until retiring again in 1989 and returning to Little Falls. Russell volunteered at St. Gabriel's Hospital. He was a member of the American Legion Post #46, Little Falls Rifle & Pistol Club, Little Falls Historical Society, Minnesota Fishing Museum, and The Red Green Possum Lodge. Russell enjoyed fishing and attending auctions. He will be remembered for his sense of humor and practical jokes.
