



## Sibylla M. 'Billie' Jevric

February 2, 1923 - April 24, 2012

Sibylla (Billy) Jevric 89 year old resident of Little Falls, MN for 57 years, died April 24, 2012 at St. Otto's Care Center, after a long and courageous battle with breast cancer.

Sibylla was born in Cologne, Germany on February 2, 1923, the youngest of three children, to Josef & Gretchen (Weiler) Schmitt. Living in Germany at a time of dramatic economic and political upheaval, she was witness to the rise and fall of the Third Reich in its entirety. She has some interesting stories to tell.

After high school, she attended the University of Cologne pursuing a pre-dentistry curriculum. She gained admission to the University of Cologne Dental School and graduated with the D.D.S. degree. While in dental school, she met her future husband Rad Jevric, a fellow student, who persuaded her after marriage to embark on a great adventure, he had long dreamed of, to leave problems of Europe behind and journey to America.

In 1955, they decided to try small town life, settling in Little Falls, MN. Sibylla decided at this time to sacrifice her career ambition for the good of her husband and young son, Nicholas. She involved herself in multiple activities including, the Variety Garden Club, the PTA, and St. Gabriel's Hospital Auxiliary. Boredom was a condition that never afflicted her, there were myriad activities to challenge her, whether it be creating her own wardrobe or painting her own house.

Sibylla is survived by her son, Dr. Nicholas Jevric and his spouse, Virginia

Jevric (McNichols) of Corpus Christi, grandchildren Melinda Jevric of Houston, Justin Jevric of Austin, Texas, and friend and longtime companion, Dr. Michael Fa of Little Falls, MN.

She was preceded in death by her husband and soul-mate Dr. Rad Jevric, her beloved sister Dr. Elizabeth Schmitt and her brother Klaus Schmitt, both of Cologne, Germany.
