Stella M. LeBlanc was born on December 13, 1909 to the late Joe H. Houle and Lumina LaForce. She attended country school for 8 years, graduated from the Little Falls High School, and went on to Normal Teachers Training in Little Falls. She received her Associate of Arts Degree from St. Cloud Teachers College and taught in the rural schools. Stella was united in marriage to Wilfred LeBlanc on June 8, 1930 at Holy Family Church in Belle Prairie, MN. The couple farmed in the area and also enjoyed fishing, gardening, berry picking and participating in various organizations. After a number of years of research Stella published her first book, "The First Cross", which described the history of Belle Prairie, the Church, and early settlers. Stella is survived by sister, Laura Bellefeuille of Little Falls, MN; sister-in-law, Florence Houle of Little Falls, MN; and 38 nieces and nephews. Stella is preceded in death by her parents, Joe H. Houle and Lumina LaForce; husband, Wilfred LeBlanc; brothers, Leon, Ovid and Maurice.
