Viola Gladys Venske was born on February 14, 1925 in Lester Prairie, MN, to the late Gustav and Elizabeth (Karls) Venske. The family moved to Randall, MN, where Viola grew up. She was united in marriage to Eldon D. Sanders on December 25, 1943, and the couple made their home in Little Falls, where they raised their six children. In 1961, they moved to Stillwater, MN, and then relocated to California in 1965. During their retirement years, they would spend their summers in the Randall area and their winters in Apache Junction, AZ. Due to declining health, they returned to Stillwater, where they remained. Eldon passed away in 2005 after 62 years of marriage. Viola worked for many years as a cook at Linden Care Center in Stillwater, and also helped out her husband with their security service business in California. Viola enjoyed sewing, crafts, reading, poetry, and especially Native American history. She loved traveling with her husband and family, taking many trips with her brother-in-law and sister-in-law, Ivan and Dorothy Sanders.
