Virginia "Virgie" C. Litke, 79 year old resident of Little Falls, passed away Saturday, December 10, 2022, at St. Gabriel's Hospital. Mass of Christian Burial will be on Tuesday, December 20, 2022, at St. Joseph's Catholic Church in Pierz, MN, at 11:30 A.M., with Father Kenneth Popp officiating. Visitation will be from 10:00-11:30 A.M., on Tuesday, December 20, 2022, at St. Joseph's Catholic Church. Burial will take place in the Minnesota State Veterans Cemetery. Caring for Virginia and her family is the Shelley Funeral Chapel of Pierz.

Virginia Clara Juetten was born on December 13, 1942, to the late Nicholas and Leona (Heimenz) Juetten. Virgie grew up on the family farm near Buckman, MN. She was united in marriage to the love of her life, Lawrence M. Litke of Pierz, on February 14, 1961. Virgie followed Larry back to Fort Bragg in South Carolina, and lived there until Larry's discharge. They returned to the Pierz area for a short time following Larry's discharge, then moved to Blaine where they raised their two sons, Paul and Jeffery. Virgie retired from Woolworths in 1994, and the couple moved to the family cabin on Sullivan Lake. She loved watching the sunrise and sunsets at the lake, and really loved sitting on the deck watching the great-grandchildren play. She spent winters in Arizona, and summers at Sullivan Lake surrounded by family and friends. Virginia moved to Little Falls to be with family in 2020. She loved visiting with friends and family, traveling, setting puzzles, and playing cards.

She will be deeply missed by all.
