



## Warren Youngberg

November 3, 1920 - April 8, 2010

Warren Youngberg was born on November 3, 1920 in Onamia, Minnesota to Joseph and Katherine (Olson) Youngberg. The family farmed in Dailey Township where Warren attended country school. On June 21, 1944 he enlisted in the United States Navy. Warren was stationed in the Pacific during WWII. While home on leave he was introduced to Alice Gibas and it was love at first sight. Warren returned to duty and was the recipient of the American Theater Ribbon, Asiatic-Pacific Ribbon and the Purple Heart, "Let it be known that he who wears the military order of the Purple Heart has given of his blood in the defense of his homeland and shall forever be revered by his fellow countrymen." On December 4, 1945 Warren was Honorably Discharged from service. After his return to the Onamia area, Warren and Alice were united in marriage on September 28, 1946 in Onamia.. The couple farmed in Dailey Township. He also did plumbing work and was employed at Kathio State Park. Warren was a member of the Onamia American Legion and VFW.

Warren is survived by his wife, Alice of Onamia, MN; son, Ken of Onamia, MN; daughters, Dolores (Don) Oien of Foley, MN, Kathy (Larry) Nelson of Maple Grove, MN, Janet Hanson of Brooklyn Park, MN; sisters, Irene Johnson of Milaca, MN, Marian Lazorik of Milaca, MN; grandchildren, Renee, Tom, Ted, Karen, Michelle; great-grandchildren, Matt, Michael, Kristin, Sam, Tori, Spencer, Sophia, Cullen, and Carter.
