In 1961 he started Bill's Standard Service on the west side of Little Falls and later moved the business to downtown Little Falls in January of 1963. Bill operated the service station for 40 years before selling it to Josh and Marianne Bloom in 2004. He was united in marriage to Jeanette Stiller on August 26, 1959, and the couple later divorced. Bill was then united in marriage to Sandra Ahrens on July 30, 1968. He was a lifelong member of First United Church in Little Falls, Lone Eagle Auto Club, Little Falls Lions Club, Little Falls Flyer Athletic

Booster and the St. Gabriel's Hospital Auxiliary. In his free time, he loved going on motorcycle trips, volunteering, attending sporting events, fishing, bowling league, traveling and spending time with friends and family. Bill was dearly loved and will be greatly missed.

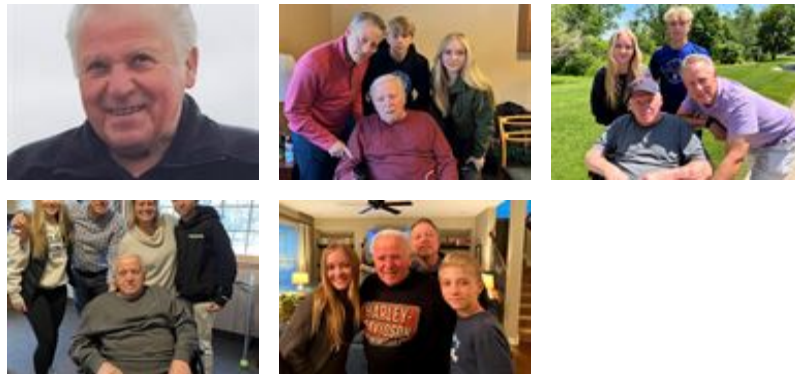
