Yona M. Scholl, 93 year old resident of Little Falls, MN, passed away on Wednesday, May 21, 2025 at the Little Falls Care Center. A Memorial Service will be held at 12 noon on Saturday, May 31, 2025 at Faith Lutheran Church in Little Falls, with Pastor Mark Johnson officiating, and a visitation starting at 10 AM Saturday at the church. 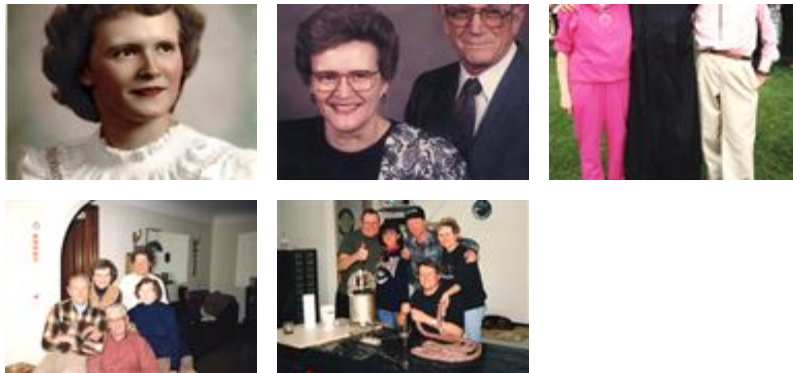
